Speech Day and Prize-giving Ceremony: Celebrating Student Success

The annual Speech Day and Prize-giving Ceremony was held on Friday, 22nd November, 2024. The College had the pleasure of having Professor Lai-Shan Tam, Professor of the Department of Medicine and Therapeutics, a Specialist in Rheumatology, and Head of the Division of Rheumatology at the Chinese University of Hong Kong, as the Guest of Honour. Professor Tam is an alumna of our College who exemplifies the spirit of SSC. She is not just an accomplished scholar but, above all, a selfless, dedicated doctor who upholds the highest standards of professionalism.

In 2003, Hong Kong faced one of the most severe public health crises in recent memory: SARS. The outbreak began at the Prince of Wales Hospital, in Ward 8A. Patients and doctors succumbed to an unknown disease with an unknown mode of transmission. In the midst of this atmosphere of fear and frustration, Professor Tam volunteered to serve in Ward 8A. In her speech, she shared her knowledge and advancements in the field of medical intelligence with the students, encouraging them that life is a journey, not a destination. They should embrace challenges, cherish friendships, and always follow their passions. She added, students have the power to create the life they desire. So, go out there, take risks, and make some noise.

Over 100 prizes, spanning sports, music, and subject-specific achievements, were awarded to our students.

教育局局長蔡若蓮博士及多位教育局同工於二零二四年十二月十日（星期二）親臨本校探訪宿舍部，期間由校董會主席錢果豐博士及馬李敏慧校長暨舍監率領本校老師和College Ambassadors同學接待。

錢博士與蔡局長分享本校始於1903年建校至今的歷史演變，講解學校寄宿生活對傳承歷史及全人教育的重要性，並介紹過去120年本校如何隨著香港社會變化而與時並進，栽培了許多優秀的社會領袖。蔡局長讚賞本校是香港的優秀教育品牌，對社會發展貢獻良多，鼓勵本校於現今香港「由治及興」的關鍵時刻，繼續善用學校的教育優勢，為社會以至全球栽培更多傑出人才。

隨後，一眾師生陪同蔡局長參觀位於書院大樓內的西翼女生宿舍及College House宿舍。副舍監蘇俊傑助理校長及宿舍經理潘朋智先生沿途介紹宿舍設施及宿生作息生活。六位宿生（6D 王珮綺、5L 陳映竹、5D 楊林僊、6D 莊栢熙、5Y 楊尊及5D 覃正鴻）與蔡局長分享住宿生活點滴，表示住宿除了省卻不少交通時間外，更可以讓他們全情投入校園生活，學習與同輩和睦共處。同時，由於同學來自於不同文化背景的家庭，造就了普通話、粵語及英語三種語言並用的優秀語言沉浸環境。此外，其中一位家在深圳的宿生表示宿舍老師在日常生活中悉心照料，尤其是兩年前封關的日子，她長時間未能回家與親人見面，幸得宿舍部同工愛護，照顧宿生的身心靈需要，帶他們外出共享佳餚來慰藉思家之情，對此深表謝意。

最後，蔡局長讚賞本校宿舍部為學生提供優質的宿舍生活，是本港宿舍學校的模楷，更邀請本校同工將來與本地學校分享經驗，共享教育智慧，成就香港教育多元豐富的新趨勢。



走馬神州覽古都—— 記「洛陽、鄭州歷史文化研習團」二、三事

2024年6月22日，由陳國培老師、黃志文老師及巫映紅老師率領的「洛陽、鄭州歷史文化研習團」出發了，此次行程共六天，至6月27日回程，其中多有可記可感之事，不妨在此稍作分享：

首先，是次行程取道深圳機場前赴鄭州，本以為清早自香港過境，人多事多，必然阻滯重重，但事實卻是路路暢通，各同學亦準時現身，令跨境搭機竟成明智之選。

行程先落腳鄭州，鄭州雖云中原交通重鎮，新建區高樓處處，但街上行人稀疏，同學參觀地標建築「玉米樓」，聊稱到此一遊。

翌日開展豐富行程，先登嵩山少林寺，探幽千年古剎，遠眺高僧浮屠，近觀武僧技擊表現，有謂「天下武功出少林」，信焉！及後參觀古觀星台，更令同學佩服古人對天象星宿和自然知識的洞明和睿智。

接着走訪古都洛陽，重點參觀龍門石窟，同學均驚嘆北魏以來宗教藝術的偉大和巧妙，胡人漢化造就隋唐盛世，掀開中華文化光輝的一頁。另一方面，同學亦通過親手製作唐三彩，切身體驗古代藝術如何在生活上得以煉成。

洛陽古都遺跡處處，同學穿梭參觀隋代大運河博物館和古墓博物館，既認識隋唐以來中國版圖上貫通南北的水路交通發展，又探索北魏以來歷朝古人的生死觀。

由洛陽轉至開封，遊歷大宋古都汴京，參觀州橋遺址考古工程，同學可以近距離考察考古活動的進行，認識考古現場的發現如何重塑昔日大宋京師的繁華風貌。同日下午，同學遊樂於清明上河園，步進昔日北宋瓦子、勾欄的娛樂生活，投入古人的生活氛圍。

此行每晚均有研習討論，同學由起初的怯於發言，到最後都能勇於表達而且言之有物，兼且同學每天都要寫旅遊日誌，記錄行程所見所聞，為此行體驗留下真切之印記。

人生逆旅，福禍相依，行程最後離境鄭州，就突然遇上國內某些空域禁飛，航班延誤達幾十小時！於是暗忖當初的「明智之選」，終究要看是否能笑到最後！



夏雨最是捉摸不定，原本風平浪靜的蒼穹轉瞬間便淹沒在一場酣暢淋漓的大雨裏。或是大人的哀怨聲，或是老人的嘆氣聲，都與千萬縷銀絲在大地纏綿。綴滿水色的屋簷是孩子們的傘，偶有幾滴頑皮的雨滴從那兒墜落到糖果店透亮的玻璃窗上，映襯著他們的望眼欲穿。他們與那一絲絲繽紛的甜蜜僅有一窗之隔，卻又不僅如此。有時，他們也會從口袋摸索出幾枚硬幣，與同行的夥伴湊錢買糖吃。但大部分時間裏，他們只能看看……

延綿不斷的秋雨與凜冽的風交雜，在我心裏蕩起了一道道漣漪。細碎的雨滴零零落地浸透著我單薄的衣衫，像是一種慢性折磨，讓我直打哆嗦。背上沉甸甸的書包日復一日地壓迫著我的神經，帶來麻木的痛楚。學校到家的距離是我唯一可以從繁忙的學業中稍作喘息的機會，隨著我的一呼一吸，空氣裏氳氳著如炊煙般的霧氣；手也不自覺地伸進口袋，漫無目的地翻找著裡面有沒有可以把玩的物件，以消遣漫長的路程。幸好，我摸到了一顆糖。

「今天輪到大家給一心買糖吃了！」夥伴的這句話是我長久的期盼。年幼的孩子還不知金錢為何物，家長便只會隨意扔個硬幣了事。但我們可聰明著，知道湊齊幾個鐵片就能換到一顆糖。於是，我常常與同伴湊錢去糖果店，輪流為大家換取片刻的甜蜜。而今天，我終於可以把那絲魂牽夢縈的甜實實地抓在手裡了。我撕開糖紙，把它虔誠地放進嘴裏，再慢慢閉上眼睛，學著電視機裡美食節目的主持人那樣，感受水果的清香味如雪一般在舌尖漸漸化開。那幸福的滋味使我忘乎所以，竟跑到雨中伸開雙臂，任憑細雨濕潤衣衫，從中賒取清涼，大笑一場。小孩子哪有那麼多顧慮？同伴看我如此享受，都紛紛從屋簷中跑出來，陪我嬉笑打鬧。那時，我咧起嘴角說：「要是天天都能如此就好了。」夥伴自然以為我說的是吃糖，於是故作深沉地看向我。「大人們說，以後考上好大學，找到好工作後，要多少糖有多少。」

踏進家門，宣告我與風雨奪路的戰爭終於迎來了勝利，可我也因此變成了一隻「落湯雞」。或許是抗爭的過程中花掉了太多力氣，以至於我沒有換衣服便直往床上倒去。看著熟悉的天花板，我像是想起了什麼似的，從兜裏掏出了那顆已經被壓扁的糖，思索著這個陌生的物件究竟從何而來。大抵是今天回答問題時老師送的罷，她那時問我：「快樂是什麼？」我心中閃過一百分的試卷，一疊厚厚的零用錢，一句老師的誇獎，最後卻駐足於一顆糖上。真奇怪，明明我早已不愛吃糖了。它就這樣被我隨手丟在桌上，靜靜地躺著。

「怎麼會有人不喜歡吃糖啊？」我向母親邊抱怨，邊走在回家的小路上。母親的眼裡嵌滿了無奈，欲言又止，最後摸著我的頭道：「或許是他們吃膩了吧！任何美好的事物終有盡頭，你別太傷心。」是啊，自從升上小學後，夥伴紛紛退出了湊錢買糖的行列。是他們的口味變了？還是逐漸鼓起的錢包足夠支持他們獨自買糖了？我不知道，我只知道從那之後吃到的每一顆糖都沒有那一天吃到的甜蜜，與夥伴買快樂的日子連同那場夏雨在我人生中漸行漸遠……

「快樂是無價的，是買不到的……」我提筆在作業本裏洋洋灑灑地寫著。對於中三的我來說，快樂確實是奢侈品。密密麻麻的測驗和排山倒海的作業如海嘯一般向我湧來，我既要擔心作業的質量，又要憂心小測的成績。無奈之下，我與學業做了場交易：我把以前買糖的時間、交際的時間、發現生活快樂的時間全批發賣給了學習，以換取現在的好成績。那年陪我淋雨的夥伴怎麼樣了？去哪裡了？我不得而知。

休憩間隙，我掃視著桌前貼著的目標大學的宣傳單張和作業堆裏那顆觸目的糖，心頭一酸，不由地繼續寫著。

「曾幾何時，我以為快樂是可以買到的，夥伴的離去沒有停下我買糖的腳步。可再次嚙下唾手可得的糖，我卻再也嘗不到那絲沁人心脾的清甜了；取而代之的，是無盡的甜膩。糖還是那顆糖，到底是我變了。我想獲得優異的成績、考上好的大學、擁抱光明的未來……暮然發現，我想要的已遠不止一顆糖。我想要的東西越來越多，越來越複雜，越來越難追求到了。這或許是好事吧，大人們都說這是有大志向的表現，將來十有八九能成一番事業，被鮮花與掌聲簇擁。但，我又何嘗不懷念以前簡單的快樂呢？那場夏雨或許只是我的黃粱一夢。」

小孩子的快樂總是那樣簡單，一顆糖，一場雨，一聲與母親的撒嬌，都能讓我甜在心頭。可人總是善變的，改變的，又豈止是口味呢？那絲清甜在一年年的成長，一份份的作業中被逐漸沖淡。曾經我以為長大了，有更多錢了，糖果店前的玻璃窗就能輕鬆跨過。可等我真的到了那一天，卻發現那層窗離我越來越遠了。如今才悟到，那絲甜是「物是人非事事休，欲語淚先流」，也是無人可以留住的曾經。

年幼的孩子啊，我現在有能力寄給你吃不完的糖了，你是否能讓那絲甜漫過成長，拂過時間，跨越那一層玻璃窗的距離，來到我身邊？

秋雨輕輕摩挲著靠著堆積如山的作業前的玻璃窗，勾勒出它們沈重的輪廓，也為我心裡蒙上了一層陰霾。突然來了興致，我慢慢剝開那顆躺在桌上的糖，學著年少時鄭重的模樣，把它輕放在嘴中，仔細品味——

不知是不是我的錯覺，我好像在某一剎那品到了一絲來自十年前的清香。

In order to enhance our students' understanding of the culture of our country, the Citizenship and Social Development Department and the Music Department jointly arranged a Cantonese opera education program, the Tea House Student Matinees Scheme, for our S4 students on 10th October, 2024. Through narrated performances, traditional Cantonese music demonstrations, and interactive facilitator-led discussion sessions, students explored the art of Cantonese opera and traditional Chinese culture, as well as its relevance to contemporary society.

The following is a reflection about the program by 4D To Hoi Ching:

'Cantonese Opera impresses me with its singing-style music and dialogue. It's very special because I haven't heard anything like it before experiencing the Cantonese Opera Programme. The way the actors and actresses express their feelings on stage, as well as their dialogue, requires immense vocal and acting skills. Thus, I am very impressed and would like to watch more Cantonese Opera soon.'

To promote Cantonese Opera in Hong Kong, I suggest offering free tickets to senior citizens, children, and students, while other groups may enjoy discounted tickets. By providing free or discounted tickets, they could attend Cantonese Opera performances without worrying about the cost, which can sometimes be a little pricey, and some may be reluctant to pay for tickets. Lowering the cost of attending performances may encourage more people to watch Cantonese Opera, giving them the chance to learn more about this art form.'


